- 4. Once you receive your username and password, click on **www.solaro.com**.
- 5. Enter your **username** and **password** and click **Log in**.

Mobile App

Accessing Kanopy Kids

- 2. Find your library and click "Add a Library Card". Enter your library card barcode and PIN number.
- 2. Once logged in, select **Kids** on the top right corner.
- **3. Kids** will now remain logged in until manually exited, or the account is logged out.

IMPORTANT

Logging out and back into your account switches out of **Kids mode** by default.

▶ Parental Controls

Kids can have their own Kanopy account if they have their own email address and library card barcode number.

However, Kids mode will still have to be activated each time they log on.

Parents can set up parental controls within their account which makes it impossible to exit Kids mode without a PIN.
